COLOR PALETTE

Primary Palette

Orange is used as the unifying color for the assets that encompass all 3 foundations.



Secondary: C0 M70 Y100 K10 #DC661E

Secondary Palette

The secondary palette is used for assets that highlight an individual foundation. Each foundation has their own primary and secondary color. The primary should be used for solid backgrounds, text, etc... The secondary color should only be used for the foundation's corresponding pattern.

Headline & Body




PATTERN

Each foundation has it's own unique pattern that follows it's brand. The pattern must always use the darker corresponding color in the secondary palette above. The patterns should only be used on assets that highlight that individual foundation. They should NOT be combined on one asset. If the asset is highlighting more than one foundation then use the primary orange color only. Do not use alternative colors for an individual asset than what is assigned above.
